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Why Slides and Forms?

- Can be used on any device that runs Chrome browser
- Program does not have to be downloaded to device
- Free!
- Versatile

Creating Slides

Is it fixed or are things are movable?

Fixed - Slides can be in presentation mode. Good for sound clips

Movable - Slides need to be in editing mode. For aspects that need to be stationary, put them as part of the "background

Put all classes in one document, with sections for the different classes. This alleviates the need to reset in between classes.

Creating Backgrounds in Slides

- Place the image as you would like it to look on the slide
- *File/Download* (.jpg or .png image of current slide)
- Select Change Background from the Slide menu
- *Choose Image* and get the image from where you saved it.
- By making it the background it cannot be shifted around.

Creating Movable Objects in Slides

When trying to give the option of having multiple copies of the same item to move around, make several copies then use *Arrange/Align/Center* then *Middle* to make a single stack of the item.

Creating Staff with Notation in Slides

Use the add-on Flat for Docs to insert musical notation.

Add-ons/Get Add-ons search Flat

It then can be accessed through the *Add-ons* menu

Things to consider when making slides

- Layer objects
- Crop out parts not wanted
- Change font color
- Change font size
- Create a custom theme




To keep slides from advancing when students click on slide, cover entire page with a transparent box and link it to that page.
